Long Ledge is a half mile in length, ranging nearly north & south. It makes in two parts, connected by a ridge of rocks. Off the south end of it is a shoal some little distance, but on each side, there is a good depth of water, about 10 feet in height above high water and has some soil on the top & also grass. NE by E from the north part of this ledge, a half mile, lies Goutys ledge, which shows itself at half tide. This is a round smooth black ledge. In running into New Meadows River you leave Long Ledge on the larboard and Gouty ledge on the starboard hand.
