

Halfway Rock is NE by E $\frac{1}{2}$ E from Cape Elizabeth, distance $10 \frac{1}{2}$ miles, and is E $\frac{1}{2}$ N from Portland Light-house, distance 9 miles. This is a low barren rock, not more than 20 yards in length at high water, but at low water it is 10 times that bigness & appears like a small island. Off both the SW & NE points the breakers run off an $\frac{1}{8}$ of a mile, off the N.E. end perhaps quarter mile, in rough weather.
