This island lies NE from the north point of Peaks Island, not more than 60 yards distance. There is a passage between the two islands with a depth of 15 feet at low water. Alltho' this passage is narrow, it has been made use of by square rigged vessels.

The island is round and full of trees, about 100 yards in diameter. There is a shoal piece of ground, SE from Pumpkin Island, one eighth of a mile distance, with 4 fathoms over it at low tides.
