

The south east point breaker bears from Portland light-house E by N  $\frac{1}{2}$  N, and the NW point of the island NE by E, each nearly at the distance of one mile and a fourth. This island is low, about the fourth of a mile in length, has but few trees and those are on the NE end. Surrounded on every side except the NW by a ragged, broken rocky shore. From the south, as well as from the east points, the breakers extend off nearly a quarter of a mile in gales of wind.

In running for Portland harbor, this island is not soon noticed, as it appears connected with Bangs' Island.
