

Extends from the Western part of what is known as Cushings Cove, in a NE direction, at the distance of nearly a half mile from the up land; 50 yards from the outer point of this ledge is placed the red buoy, in 15 feet low tides. The ledge shows itself low water. Between this ledge and the broken ridge of rocks that make from the shore, there is less than a foot of water at low Spring tides. From the middle of this ledge in a NNW direction, the mud bank commences that extends across the harbor, with 15 feet over it at very low tides.
