

From the S.W. point of this Island NW  $\frac{1}{2}$  N, distance one mile, lies a small island called Ram Island. SE from it one fourth of a mile, there is a ledge which frequently discovers itself at low water. You must guard against this ledge in either beating in or out of this road. This Ram Island is in range with the SW point of Richmonds Island & the entrance of Spurwink river. This river has a bar at the entrance, almost dry at low water & is but seldom frequented by vessels. South westerly of this river, are many dangerous rocks lying some distance from the shore.
