Mapmaking Contest!

Inviting all Maine 4th, 5th, & 6th graders to enter our Illustrated Mapmaking Contest for the chance to win \$1,000 (\$500 for you, \$500 for your class - homeschooled students welcomed)!

How To Enter:

- 1. Create an original, illustrated map (a map with pictures).
- 2. Submit your map and completed Entry Release Form to the Osher Map Library to arrive by April 30, 2021
- 3. If you're one of 10 finalists selected invite your friends and family to vote for your map online!

Important Dates:

Friday, April 30, 2021 – all submissions must be received by this date or dropped off in person (mail by April 25 to be safe)

Saturday, May 8, 2021 – 10 finalists announced, online vote begins Friday, May 15, 2021 – winner revealed!

Important Things to Know:

- Your map must be flat (2 dimensional) and no larger than 11 x 17 inches (most construction paper is 12x18, too big to scan)
- If you submit a map by mail, please make a photocopy if you
 would like to keep one as the maps will not be mailed back. You
 may also submit a high-quality photocopy and keep the original.
- If you submit a scan via email, the scan must be high quality and cropped appropriately. **No photographs please**.
- The work should be unique, creative, and unassisted
- Your completed Entry Release Form should be attached to the back side of the map.

Here's how the contest works:

- **1. Preliminary Judging.** An independent panel of judges will review all eligible entries received and select up to 10 semifinalists.
- 2. Notification of finalists. By May 8, 2021, the selected finalists will be notified.
- 3. Selection of Winning Illustrated Map. The semifinalists will be featured on Osher Map Library's Map Contest webpage, from May 8, 2021 May 15, 2021. Through a combination of community voting and Osher Map Library judges, a winning illustrated map will be selected. Limit one (1) vote per valid email address during the online voting period. Voting begins at 12:00 PM ET on May 8, 2021 and ends at 12:00 PM ET on May 15, 2021. The creator of the winning map will be notified by May 16, 2021.

4. \$1,000 cash prize to be awarded.
