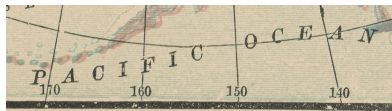
1. Letter Clue: _____

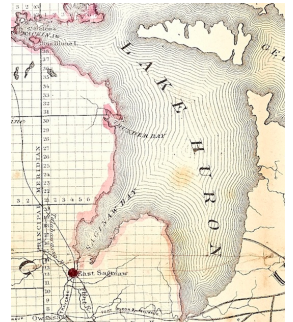
8. Letter Clue: _____

Lake Huron is another of the Great Lakes, located just to the east of Michigan. Find this image on a map made right after the Civil War.



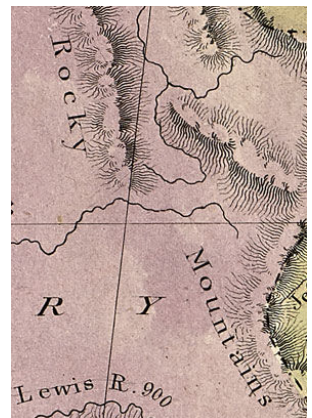
10. Letter Clue: _____

The **Great Salt Lake** is the biggest saltwater lake in the U.S. Find this image on a map made at the beginning of the California Gold Rush.



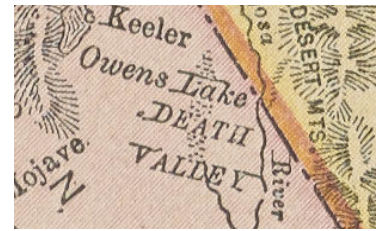
16. Letter Clue: _____

Tacoma (also called Mt. Rainier) is the most dangerous volcano in the continental U.S. Find this image on a map showing time zones.



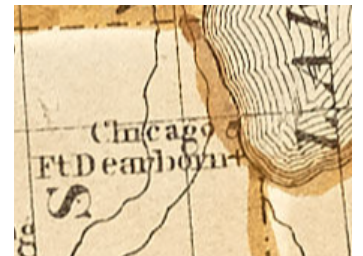

Chicago is the second largest city in the U.S. Find this on a map made during the Civil War.



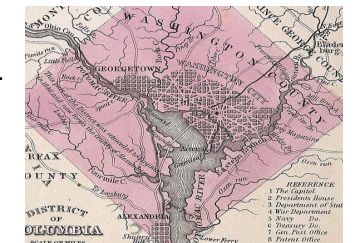
