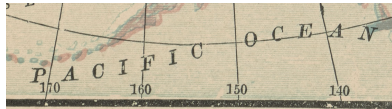
1. Letter Clue: _____

The United States is bordered on the East by the **Atlantic Ocean**. Find this exact image on a map with a lot of pictures.



2. Letter Clue: _____

The U.S. is bordered on the West by the **Pacific Ocean**. Find this image on a map that includes Alaska.



3. Letter Clue: _____

The **Gulf of Mexico** is the largest gulf connected to the U.S. Find this image on a map that shows all of North America.



4. Letter Clue: _____

The U.S. and Mexico are separated by a river, the **Rio Grande**.

Find this image on a map made after California was a state.



5. Letter Clue: _____

The longest river in the U.S. is the **Mississippi River**, which starts in Minnesota and empties into the Gulf of Mexico. Find this image on a map made before the U.S. stretched ocean to ocean.



6. Letter Clue: _____

One of the Great Lakes, **Lake Superior** is the largest lake in the U.S. Find this on a map made when Texas was its own country.



7. Letter Clue: _____

Lake Michigan, located between Wisconsin and Michigan, is another one of the Great Lakes. Find this image on a map made when Wisconsin was part of the Northwest Territory.



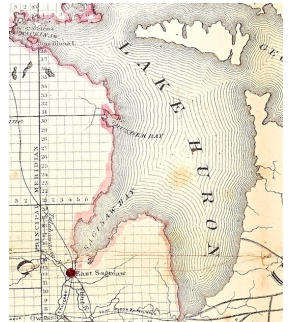
8. Letter Clue: _____

Lake Huron is another of the Great Lakes, located just to the east of Michigan. Find this image on a map made right after the Civil War.

Lake Erie, also a Great Lake, is located to the north of Ohio. Find this on a map showing the locations of reservations.



11. Letter Clue: _____

The largest mountain range in the U.S. is the **Rocky Mountains** which stretch from New Mexico up into Canada. Find this image on a map made when only one U.S. territory touched the Pacific.
