# **Mapmaking Contest!**

Inviting all **Maine 4th, 5th, & 6th graders** to enter our Illustrated Mapmaking Contest for the chance to win \$1,000 (\$500 for you, \$500 for your class - homeschooled students welcomed)!

#### **How To Enter:**

- 1. Create an original, illustrated map (a map with pictures).
- 2. Submit your map and completed Entry Release Form to the Osher Map Library to arrive by April 15, 2022
- 3. If you're one of 12 finalists selected invite your friends and family to vote for your map online!

## **Important Dates:**

Friday, April 15, 2022 – all submissions must be received by this date (mail by April 11 to be safe)

Saturday, April 23, 2022 – 12 finalists announced; online vote begins. Saturday, April 30, 2022 – Winners revealed!

## Important Things to Know:

- Your map must be flat (2 dimensional) and **no larger than 11 x 17 inches** (most construction paper is 12x18, too big to scan)
- The work should be unique, creative, and unassisted
- If you submit a map by mail, please make a photocopy if you would like to keep one as the maps will not be mailed back. You may also submit a high-quality photocopy and keep the original.
- If you submit a scan via email, the scan must be high quality and cropped appropriately. **No photographs please.**
- Your completed Entry Release Form should be attached to the back side of the map.

### Here's how the contest works:

- **1. Preliminary Judging.** An independent panel of judges (educators, cartographers, artists) will review all eligible entries received and select up to 12 finalists.
- **2. Notification of finalists.** By April 23, 2022, the selected finalists will be notified.
- 3. Selection of Winning Illustrated Maps. The finalists will be featured on Osher Map Library's Map Contest webpage, from April 23, 2021 April 30, 2022. Through the judging panel and online community voting, winning illustrated maps will be selected. Limit one (1) vote per valid email address during the online voting period. Voting begins at 12:00 PM ET on April 23, 2022 and ends at 12:00 PM ET on April 30, 2022. The creators of the winning maps will be notified by April 30, 2022.
- 4. Cash prizes to be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place, as well as "Best in Grade" prizes

THE FINE PRINT • Entries that do not comply with the contest rules and submission requirements will be disqualified; Non-winning entrants will not be individually notified of the results; Only one Osher Map Library Map Drawing Contest entry per student per year will be accepted; It is the student's responsibility to inform the Osher Map Library of any change of address; The decisions of the Osher Map Library and the Judges are final.
