<p>Modifications</p>	<p>Students who have modifications will be able to complete the project, as per their 504, IEP, etc. Students who have difficulty with the oral part of the project can meet with the instructor in order to create an alternate path for success.</p>
<p>Taking Informed Action</p>	<p>Once the board game is complete, learners will have an additional period to play everyone's game and rate them, according to the sheet provided. If used as a final for the class, the student/group will also present their game to the class in a 5-10 minute oral presentation. This also included demonstrating how the game works, key ideas, and answering the question as to why the student/group chose this topic and what lessons did they learn while working on the project.</p>
